### THE PRESIDENT'S CORNER

I would like to invite all our members to the next General Membership Meeting on June 8, 2014, at Carrabba's at 5820 Red Bug Lake Road, Winter Springs, Florida. Your Board would like to present the following changes to the Beach Boppers of Orlando Bylaws:

Section II: Duties and Responsibilities of Board of Directors.

Paragraph b) states: "The Board, in conjunction with the Finance Committee shall prepare an annual detailed line item operation budget to be presented for approval of the membership at a general membership meeting to be held within forty-five (45) days after calendar year end and a copy of the proposed budget will be provided to all members in good standing at least one week prior to the meeting. Quarterly reports, including a balance sheet and an income and expense statement, reflecting actual versus budgeted expenditures will be provided upon request to any member in good standing."

The proposed change would read as follows: "The Board, in conjunction with the Finance Committee shall prepare an annual detailed line item operation budget within forty-five (45) days after calendar year end and a copy will be provided to all members in good standing. Quarterly reports, including a balance sheet and an income and expense statement reflecting actual versus budgeted expenditures will be provided upon request to any member in good standing. This operation budge will be reviewed with the membership at the March quarterly General Membership Meeting for approval."

Paragraph f) states: "A quorum consisting of 15% of the total membership in good standing must be present at general membership meetings at which a new officer is elected and/or any meeting at which a vote will be taken to change the Charter or Bylaws. A quorum for all other membership meetings is the number of active members present for the meeting. If a quorum exists, then a majority vote consisting of 50% plus 1 of the membership present and voting is required to approve or reject a motion. An agenda will be provided prior to meeting and no items other than those on the agenda will be open for voting."

The proposed change would read as follows: "A quorum of all membership meetings is the number of active members present for the meeting. A majority vote consisting of 50% plus 1 of the membership present and voting is required to approve or reject a motion. An agenda will be provided prior to meeting and no items other than those on the agenda will be open for voting."

These changes will be presented at the next General Membership Meeting for a vote and will be decided with those members present by a majority of the vote. We aren't getting quorum percentages at our meeting, so we figure majority rules. Decision need to be made and this will help to get them accomplished. Please plan on joining us. We need your vote.

Beach Boppers has been negotiating with the Plaza Resort & Spa regarding the Orange Squeeze contract for 2016, 2017 and 2018. Although I can't say everything, I will mention it is our goal to maintain the \$119 room rate for all three years. Hopefully, we will have more details at the next General Membership Meeting. Another good reason to attend!

We have checked with the Ventura Country Club and everything has been verified for our Barbeque on July 26<sup>th</sup>. This year the cost to BBOO members will be \$10 and gusts \$17. Attached to the newsletter is Barbeque flyer. PLEASE take the time to fill out the form and mail in your check. The good is great, the music wonderful and we are looking forward to seeing all of you on the dance floor.

We are still trying to pick up Wednesday night dance attendance. It has not been good the last couple of months. We would like you all to plan on joining us both Wednesday and Sunday. Again, we need your help!!!!

And thank you for all your cards, calls and prayers after my recent foot surgery. They were certainly appreciated.
