## **BETTY WILSON**

Betty graduated from Chesnee High School in Chesnee, South Carolina. While in school, she was involved in all of the clubs and activities. She also played basketball! From age 14, Betty designed and made her own clothes. She won 4-H Awards in Design and Clothing. She played piano as part of the entertainment at her high school Senior Prom.

She graduated from Winthrop University in Rock Hill, South Carolina, where she was

very active in many clubs on campus. She was also Miss Cowpens in 1957. Betty has two children – a daughter and a son – and two grandchildren, all of whom she adores.

In 1975, Betty went to work as an agent for New York Life Insurance Company in Rock Hill, South Carolina. She stayed there until 1980. 
