I also want to thank Frank for helping with the outside floor. We hope to dance again next year on Wednesday night. I want to thank the hotel and their staff for the excellent service. A special thank you to my man Wilson. As "Pookie" Wilson would say, "That's what I do!"

The new location for the tent and dance floor worked well for us. Everyone prefers our new spot and no one complained about it, so we will keep it there next year. The outside floor did not go as well as expected and it didn't come apart any better. I am working with the hotel as I want them to put it down and take it up.

Security worked well this year. Jay, the security guard, wants us to ask him back next year, and we will. He did an excellent job.

I want to thank Dorothy Berdellans for handling the Registration Desk, and also all the volunteers who helped her. I also want to thank Betty Wilson, who did an outstanding job of selling 50/50 tickets. She outdid herself once again. We do not have the breakdown on the Squeeze, so I won't be able to share it with you at this time; however, we will send out a special email with the results.
