CHAPLAIN'S CORNER

Saint Valentine's Day is almost here, a time filled with cupids and hearts, engagements and marriages and overcrowded restaurants. This is a commercial holiday generated for profit. Sweethearts are compelled to show just how much love is worth to them. What about genuine love? The love that a mother has for her child, to forgive no matter what they have done. The love that a married couple still has for each other no matter how intense a disagreement has become. The forgiveness and "let's try again" that may happen when a relationship is at its breaking point.

Recently we were invited to the dedication ceremony at our church for a memorial to parishioner SSG Robert J. Miller, US Army Special Forces. SSG Miller "Rob" was 25 years old when he gave his earthly life in Afghanistan in the service of his country. In 2008 SSG Miller was to lead his patrol in a nighttime raid to stop a group of insurgents who had been terrorizing local Afghan villagers. Rob found his patrol pinned down by 150 insurgent fighters. The small twenty-fourman patrol was vastly outnumbered. With the enemy closing in, Rob did something extraordinary – he ordered his men to fall back. As they did this, Rob moved in the other direction drawing fire towards himself. He continued to fight providing cover and protection of his patrol. Rob died that night in battle. All other members of his patrol survived.

Rob loved his life and his men. He gave his life both for his men and his country. For this incredible act of courage and sacrifice, SSG Robert J. Miller received the Medal of Honor, the United States' highest award for military valor in action. The story of SSG Miller serves as a witness to selflessness and his love for his men and his country. We are all on a mission to live our lives for God and called to share that generous gift of self and love to those who need us. We are in this life together; we have more in common than not. One person does make a difference in different ways.
